

REMINDER: PREVENT FROZEN PIPES

With the current extremely cold weather, please take these simple steps to protect your unit and the building from water damage:

- Keep the Heat On: Set your thermostat to at least 55°, even if you are away.
- Circulate Air: Open kitchen and bathroom cabinet doors to allow warmer air to reach the plumbing.
- Drip the Faucets: Let a very thin trickle of water run from faucets located on exterior walls.

What to do if a pipe freezes-

If you turn on a faucet and only a trickle (or nothing) comes out:

- Keep the faucet open to relieve pressure.
- Contact your plumber or Building Maintenance immediately.
- Do not use a blowtorch or open flame to thaw pipes.
