Dear Farmington Woods Residents & Golf Members,

We continue to monitor information on COVID-19 with the intent to do what is best for the health and safety of valued residents, non-resident golf members and staff. This morning an order from Governor Ned Lamont was published to close all restaurants as of 8:00PM this evening until further notice with an additional ban of gatherings of 50 or more people. In support of social distancing and particular care for residents in the highest risk category, the following action has been taken at Farmington Woods:

- The Clubhouse restaurant will be open for delivery service only effective Tuesday, March 17<sup>th</sup> until further notice. Hours of operation will be Tuesday–Saturday from 12:00PM–7:00PM. A \$20 purchase is required for delivery. Please call the Clubhouse at 860-673-2419.
- The Master Association office will be closed to outside foot traffic as of Tuesday, March 17<sup>th</sup> until further notice. Residents may make payments via the overnight drop at the MA building (adjacent to the front door) or at lockboxes located at the over flow parking on Heritage Drive across from the 1-6 Heritage Drive courtyard or in the overflow parking lot on Byron Drive across from the Byron Pool. New owners to Farmington Woods will make an appointment with Office Administrator Vickie Panagakos for their new resident orientation at 860-673-6193.
- At the present time, Farmington Woods Golf Course is fully open for play as well as the driving range and practice areas.
- Committee meetings have been canceled until further notice.
- The March 27<sup>th</sup> CONNECT Free Concert with the Kerry Boys at the Clubhouse has been canceled. Please see the In the Woods 2.0 for future event updates.

With frequently updated information from the CDC and Governor Lamont, we will continue to provide updates as life in The Woods may change as a result. For the most up to date information please refer to the Center for Disease Control and the CT Department of Public Health. It is with the health of all in mind that we make these decisions.
