



### **FARMINGTON WOODS RESTAURANT INDOOR SEATING**

Governor Lamont has allowed the State of Connecticut to move into Phase 3 Reopening beginning on October 8, 2020. As a result of moving into Phase 3 and the colder weather, the Clubhouse restaurant at Farmington Woods will begin to provide limited indoor seating on October 15, 2020. The available indoor seating is limited to the number of patrons that can safely fit in the restaurant while maintaining appropriate social distancing. This allows us to open the restaurant at approximately 50% capacity. The bar and pub area will remain closed at this time to comply with executive orders and provide a safe environment for the staff and patrons.

The Clubhouse will continue its curbside pick up and delivery for those who enjoy this service.

**COVID-19 Warning:** Those showing symptoms of illness and/or those failing to comply with COVID-19 guidelines, restaurant employee instructions and posted signage will result in being asked to leave the restaurant and building.

If you have symptoms, have been exposed to anyone with symptoms, have traveled to a restricted area within the last 14 days or have been advised to quarantine for any reason, you should not patron the restaurant. All restaurant patrons assume individual risk.

Dr. Anthony Fauci, the nation's top infectious disease expert, continues to remind us that the ongoing pandemic is far from over. An inherent risk of exposure to Covid-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and those with underlying medical conditions are extremely vulnerable.

### **MANDATORY RESTAURANT RULES**

- **Face Coverings/Masks:** Masks/face coverings are required when not eating. Cloth face coverings shall be required to be worn throughout the restaurant, in the restaurant and when entering and exiting the building unless doing so would be contrary to health or safety due to medical conditions.
- **6 Foot Distancing:** Patrons must adhere to social distancing at all times possible within the facility.
- **Restricted Areas:** The only areas of the building that will be open to the public at this time will be the dining room, the adjacent indoor men's and women's restrooms as well as men's and women's golf locker rooms. The pub area, bar area and Heritage Room will remain closed. Any patron accessing a restricted area will be asked to leave the premises.
- **Enforcement:** Patrons who violate these rules or fail to follow the directions of Farmington Woods staff will be asked to leave the facility. The Master Association reserves all rights to take appropriate actions related to violations, including but not limited to restricting future access to the restaurant and/or charging back the cost to clean and sanitize as needed.
